## **OBJECTIVES**

Be a Mentor in the Workplace is an alliance spanning across 5 European countries. Its aim is to develop a mentoring culture in European organisations and companies, facilitating intergenerational dialogue and boosting the employability of young people.

Utilising the approach of work-based Lifelong Learning, older employees will act as mentors for younger employees. Both mentors and mentees are expected to develop a strong set of skills during this process. By adopting new models of learning in the workplace, as well as by using a number of innovative ICT tools, the project aspires to have a profound impact on productivity in Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) across Europe.

## **RESULTS**

The project aims to transfer a number of successful tools and methodologies to the target group of SMEs. Through this transfer process, the project will develop:

- a new ICT-based framework for setting up Mentoring schemes in SMEs;
- a methodology for certifying Mentors, including an innovative course for prospective Mentors:
- an innovative guide for establishing an effective relationship between Mentors and Mentees:
- an ICT-based training for becoming an e-Mentor including a feedback system to evaluate the mentoring scheme and its results.

In addition, the project tools will be incorporated into existing Education and Training Systems across participating countries.

Be a Mentor in the Workplace is expected to boost economic performance across Europe, enabling SMEs to become stronger and more competitive.
